Overview

1. We discussed previous actions to determine the progress made since last time we met.

Progress

Children were not required to attend this session due this being a meeting to discuss the progress of actions being worked on. Lydia and Katherine provided an update on Grandparent Gardening Week, as well as the work Wioletta is doing with the children to get the planting underway across both campuses.

Fine Dining is working much better now the selected children are able to bring a friend along to dine with them.

Nursery and Reception have been having half a jacket potato instead of a full one. The feedback from Jane Leatham on behalf of the Middays is that the children are eating more. We will continue with this for children this age, unless the feedback changes.

Katherine has ordered a board to display Food for Life information in the hall at Kersall Drive to ensure we are promoting this initiative across both schools.

Katherine discussed the trip next week to Stonebridge Farm, this is something that the children will be a part of and will be able to share their experience with the rest of the school.

Actions

 teachers.

- 5. LM To contact Morrison's to see if they are still running there gardening initiative
