Dolphins: On Thursday 28th September the Dolphins will be going to the local shops. There will be two trips, both AM and PM Parent/carer volunteers are needed and will be most welcome.

<u>Year 1 and 2:</u> Key stage 1 children will be taking part in an 'Autumnal walk' to Vernon Park on Wednesday 20th September. This will relate to our Science work on Seasons and during the visit we will collect objects related to autumn, take photos and play on the park.

All children will need to wear a waterproof coat and may bring wellies or old trainers to change into as it may be muddy.

If you are able to help your child's class, please tell your child's teacher; your help is always appreciated. We will leave school at approximately 1:45 and be back in school ready for home-time.

<u>Year 1 and 2:</u> Homework Project- children are to create a super hero gadget, poster, mask or cape. Their project must cover an area no bigger than an A4 sheet of paper (especially if you make a cape!), so that they can be displayed on the shelves in the school hall. They are to be brought into school by 29th September. Get creative!



<u>Year 3 and 4 homework:</u> As part of our current topic, 'Selfies' the children will be looking into cameras, how they work and how they have changed over time. We would like children in year 3 and 4 to make a model of a camera that can be displayed in school. Children can choose whether their model represents the early days of the invention of the camera or a more modern design. **Due Friday 29th September.**

<u>Year 5 and 6:</u> Unfortunately the Planetarium visit that was planned for this half term and mentioned on our parent overview- linked to our 'Out of This World' topic- is no longer being offered by the provider. It was a free initiative however they can no longer fulfil this commitment. During our National Space Centre visit on Tuesday 3rd October, the children will visit a planetarium as part of this trip.
