Children entering the school gates after this time will be directed to the office to sign in as late. We are trying to improve punctuality so please support us in reaching our goal. Early Birds breakfast club runs from 8:15am every morning in the hall and is free to drop in to. Food is served until 8:30am.

Your support during our previous cake carnival was very much appreciated and we raised a fantastic total for charity. There will be activities to take part in and delicious cakes to eat. Flu vaccination for F2, Years 1, 2, 3 and 4: The annual flu vaccination will be taking place for all children in Reception and Years 1, 2, 3 and 4 on **Monday 16th October**. Information and consent forms have recently been sent out. Please can these be returned to the school office by **Friday 29th September**.

Bikes and Scooters: Can parent/carers please ensure that the children are not riding bikes or scooters on the school premises and that they are not playing on other children's scooters which have been left in the shelter. At the end of the day, the shelter should be empty so please remember to take the bikes and scooters home!

Staff Absence: Unfortunately Miss Mackay (F1 TA) is currently absent from school and so we are covering her absence with staff from within school. This may mean the children are working with another adult but they are all familiar to the children. Mrs Gibbs is the F1 teacher and is in F1 every day except for her PPA time where Mrs Yorke will be covering her. We wish Miss Mackay a speedy return to work.
