Information and consent forms have recently been sent out. Please can these be returned to the school office by **Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September**.

At this time, you will have the opportunity to collect your child from class so that they can attend the carnival with you. If you do take your child to the cake carnival you are free to take them home after enjoying sometime in the hall.

Cakes which have been home-made by class teachers and children will be available to buy. Any children not collected will remain with a teacher from their key stage and will be ready to collect as normal at 3:30pm.

Of course the aim is to raise as much money as possible for the wonderful charity that is Macmillan Cancer Research. Any cake or money donations would be much appreciated. Any cake donations can be handed into your child's class teacher from Wednesday onwards.

<u>Contact Numbers and other information</u>: In the brown envelope you will find your most up to date details which we hold on our computer system. Could we also ask that an email address be added if missing? Please sign and make any changes to the data collection sheet and hand in at the school office. Thank you.

**Dinner money:** Please can we remind you that dinner money must be paid to the school office in advance on Mondays. The current price per meal is £1.95 meaning the weekly cost is £9.75.

**<u>Bikes and Scooters:</u>** Can parent/carers please ensure that the children are not riding bikes or scooters on the school premises and that they are not playing on other children's scooters which have been left in the shelter. At the end of the day the shelter should be empty so please remember to take the bikes and scooters home!

<u>Year 5 & 6:</u> Due to the Year 6 York Residential next week, homework will be given out on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October (rather than the residential week) to be completed by Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October. Homework will return to normal the WB 9<sup>th</sup> October, being handed out on a Thursday, to be returned the following Friday. This ensures that homework is consistent across Year 5 & 6.

During our Year 6 York Residential (which runs from Tues 26<sup>th</sup>-Fri 29<sup>th</sup> Sep) Tigers class will have Mr Turner Rowe and Miss Martindale and the Lions class will remain with Mr Nixon. The Jaguars will be split between the Tigers and Lions. Miss Allen and Miss Shaw will both be on the residential therefore using teachers that the children are used to working with across the phase will ensure consistency for the children remaining in school this week.
