<u>Welcome Back!</u> The new school year has started very well with all children looking super smart and ready to go. The new Foundation 2 children are doing brilliantly learning all the new routines and finding their way around the school. Exciting things have been happening in classrooms and the teachers are impressed with the behaviour of all children and their positive attitudes to work.

If any trips or clubs need reply slips, they will be attached and you will just need to complete the one relevant for your child. Staff will make sure you are given enough notice about events and each class will still send home their own newsletter and topic overviews every half term so you know what the children are learning about. We hope this system works better for everyone and as always your feedback is welcome.

<u>Welcome Meetings:</u> Thank you to all parents/carers who attended the Welcome meetings this week – we hope you found them informative and a good opportunity to speak to your child's new teachers. If you were unable to make the meeting, try and speak to the teacher at the start or end of the day or contact them via the school office. <u>Prize Winners:</u> At the end of July we held our first Celebration assembly. Five children in Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 were chosen to receive a special award plus our Heathfield Ambassador Award for a departing member of Year 6. The children know what they have to aim for at the end of this year!

<u>Midday Vacancies:</u> We currently have a vacancy for Midday Supervisors on a permanent contract basis. We are looking for applicants who can be available to start as soon as possible. Reception, Year 1 and 2 Milk: Our school provides a milk scheme that is available to all of our pupils in our Nursery, Foundation and KS1 classes. From the start of this academic year, we have changed our milk provider and now order our milk through Cool Milk. If your child is over the age of five and does not receive benefit based free school meals you will now need to register with Cool Milk and pay them directly rather than paying at the school office in order for your child to receive milk each day.
