<u>Marvelous Me</u>: We are sorry for anyone who has experienced problems with Marvelous Me in the last few days. As we no longer use it at Heathfield, we recommend that you delete the App from your phone.

<u>Coffee Morning</u>: Come along to our Heathfield Parents coffee morning on Wednesday 14th February at 9.15am in the conservatory.

<u>Absence:</u> It is the responsibility of the parents/carers of all pupils at Heathfield, from 3 – 11 years, to inform the school on the first day of their child's absence. A letter will be sent if no contact has been made, however failure to inform the school of reasons of absence will result in an **unauthorised absence** being recorded. **Any child, who is absent for more than 3 days, is required to bring in medical evidence as proof of illness.** Failure to inform the school of a child's reason of absence or being absent for 3 or more days, may result in a home visit from a member of our Attendance Team. **Parent/carers whose child has below 90% attendance will be informed by letter each half term,** even if they have had the absences authorised.

Leave of Absence: Schools have a discretionary power to grant a pupil time off school during the term for exceptional circumstances. Parents should fill in a leave of absence request form and give at least 6 weeks' notice of the event. **This does not include holidays in term time.** . If families choose to take their child out of school during term time for the reason of a holiday, an unauthorised leave of absence or the school has information that they have taken a holiday during term time, they will be referred to Education Welfare to be issued with a penalty notice.

<u>Midday Supervisor Vacancies</u>: We currently have three vacancies for Midday Supervisors. If you or anyone you know is interested in these positions please collect an application form from either school office. Completed application forms should be returned to the school office by Friday 2nd February.
