We will leave school at 9am and will return at 3.45pm.

The children will be learning about Nottingham and its history including the legend of Robin Hood, through taking part in various workshops run by the experienced centre staff and include a Robin Hood information workshop, Orienteering and Den building in the forest. Children are expected to wear school uniform with sensible outdoor footwear (it may be muddy!) and a waterproof coat as the whole day will be outdoors.
