Octopus and Turtles trip to Brackenhurst Environmental Education Centre: On Wednesday 16th May, the Turtles and Octopus classes are going to go to Brackenhurst Environmental Education Centre as part of their 'Into the Woods' topic. They will be leaving school at 8.45am and should be back for the end of the school day depending on traffic.

They will spend half the day doing a Traditional Tales workshop and the other half of the day doing den building in the woods. Further information will be sent nearer the time with what children need to wear.
