Dolphins: trip to Brackenhurst Environmental Education Centre

On Thursday 17th May, we are going to go to Brackenhurst Environmental Education Centre as part of our 'Into the Woods' topic. We will leave school at 9am and should be back for the end of the school day, depending on traffic.

We will spend half the day doing a 'Traditional Tales' workshop and the other half of the day den building in the woods. We will send more information nearer the time with what children need to wear.
