Behaviour in School: Miss Dickens would like to thank you for the support in embracing the red and green slips, which are given out by the teachers. These are a way of communicating about behaviour. It works best if parents/carers reinforce the message with a reward for a green slip or a sanction for a red slip. Partnerships between home and school are very important for the children. Sadly, we are seeing too often children not able to keep their hands and feet to themselves and not doing as they are asked the first time so your help in reminding children of the school rules is appreciated.

New Menus: Your child will today receive a copy of the new school dinner menu, which will start from Monday 4th June. Don't forget that all children in our Reception and KS1 classes are eligible under the Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme to have a free school meal.

Children, who are in the Nursery and Years 3 and 4, unless eligible to Free School Meals, will need to pay for school dinners. The current price is £1.95 per meal meaning that the weekly cost is £9.75.

<u>Edwards and Blake Shining Stars Promotion</u>: On Tuesday 12th June our caterers, Edwards and Blake, will launch a 4-week promotion called **Shining Stars** which we hope will encourage children to try new foods during school meals. There will be certificates and prizes on offer. Further information will be sent out during the first week back after half term.
