Next Thursday, children in Dolphin class will be going on their trip to Brackenhurst Education Centre in Southwell. On this day the children will be working in the grounds and woodland areas surrounding the centre. Leave of Absence: Schools have a discretionary power to grant a pupil time off school during the term for exceptional circumstances. Parents should fill in a leave of absence request form and give at least 6 weeks' notice of the event. **This does not include holidays in term time.** If families choose to take their child out of school during term time for the reason of a holiday, an unauthorised leave of absence or the school has information that they have taken a holiday during term time, they will be referred to Education Welfare to be issued with a penalty notice.
