<u>Congratulations:</u> Well done to Rory Sneath from Class Hares who won the £10 voucher in the Special School Dinner raffle.

<u>New Menus:</u> Your child will today receive a copy of the new school dinner menu, which will start from Monday 4th June. Don't forget that all children in our Reception and KS1 classes are eligible under the Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme to have a free school meal.

Children, who are in the Nursery and Years 3-6 unless entitled to Free School Meals, will need to pay for school dinners. The current price is £1.95 per meal meaning that the weekly cost is £9.75.

<u>Edwards and Blake Shining Stars Promotion:</u> On Monday 11th June our caters, Edwards and Blake, will launch a 4-week promotion called Shining Stars which we hope will encourage children to try new foods during school meals. There will be certificates and prizes on offer. Further information will be sent out during the first week back after half term.

<u>Midday Supervisor Vacancies:</u> We currently have Midday Supervisor vacancies across both our campuses. If you or anyone you know is interested in these positions please collect an application form from either school office.

<u>Final Payment date for residentials:</u> If your child has a place in any of our residentials this year, please ensure the balance is paid on time.

Hathersage - Final payment is required before Friday 29th June 2018

York - Final payment is required before Friday 14th September 2018

London - Final payment is required before Friday 20th July 2018

<u>School uniform orders for the new school year:</u> School uniform orders for the new school that are received by Friday 8th June will be delivered before the end of the summer term. Order forms can be collected from the school office. Full payment is required at the time of ordering.

<u>Leave of Absence:</u> Schools have a discretionary power to grant a pupil time off school during the term for exceptional circumstances. Parents should fill in a leave of absence request form and give at least 6 weeks' notice of the event. <u>This does not include holidays in term time.</u> . If families choose to take their child out of school during term time for the reason of a holiday, an unauthorised leave of absence or the school has information that they have taken a holiday during term time, they will be referred to Education Welfare to be issued with a penalty notice.

Absences of 3 or more days will require medical documentation to be authorised and could result in a home visit.
