Leave of Absence: Schools have a discretionary power to grant a pupil time off school during the term for exceptional circumstances. Parents should fill in a leave of absence request form and give at least 6 weeks' notice of the event. **This does not include holidays in term time.** If families choose to take their child out of school during term time for the reason of a holiday, an unauthorised leave of absence or the school has information that they have taken a holiday during term time, they will be referred to Education Welfare to be issued with a penalty notice.

<u>Edwards and Blake Shining Stars Promotion:</u> On Tuesday 12th June our caterers, Edwards and Blake, will launch a 4-week promotion called Shining Stars which we hope will encourage children to try new foods during school meals.

The pupils will be given bingo cards, which will be marked by a staff member each day. The pupil being served their main course or pudding (depending on the day – it will say on the Bingo Card) will be eligible for a prize. A selection of prizes will be awarded to 1-2 pupils each day. There are an assortment of prizes including shoulder bags, water bottles, coloured pencils, rulers and pencil cases. A selection of stickers will be awarded to students on an ad hoc basis. Certificates which will be awarded to each child on completion of a full 4-week take up of school meals.

From the start of the promotion, each school's uptake will be measured and the school that shows the greatest uptake will be awarded £500 worth of books and equipment with the next four schools being awarded £300 worth of books and equipment.
