#### Reminders:

- The gates open for Early Birds Breakfast Club at 8:15am.
- Please <u>do not</u> let your children play on the equipment on the playgrounds before or after school as there is no staff supervision at these times.
- Both entrance gates are open from 8:30am so you can be on the yard ready for the morning bell to go at 8:45am. One of the Leadership Team will be on the gate in the morning; either Miss Dickens, Mr Battison, Mrs Abasspour or Miss Hawkes.
- Teachers will greet you on the yard at 8:45am and then lead the children into class.
- We ask that children are not running around and playing before school, we expect a calm start to the morning and ask for your support with this.
- The side gate is locked at 8:45am to enable Kieran (our site manager) to lock the other gates around school and to clear the hall of tables and benches.
- Only the main entrance is open at home time.
- Any children coming through the gates after 8:45am but before 8:50am will be entered into our Late Gate book.

- Any children entering school after 8:50am will need to go through the office and be signed in on the screen. Lateness impacts on the children's learning as well as the workload for the office. Please be on time to school.
- Children are not to ride bikes and scooters on the school grounds please dismount at the gates.
- We expect all adults who enter our school gates to be good, positive role models to the children please consider your conduct whilst on the school site.
- There are no dogs allowed on site.
- We are a no smoking site and also request that you do not smoke near to the gates. Thank You.

**EYFS 'Express yourself!' dress up day – Friday 21**<sup>st</sup> **September:** On Friday 21st September, we will be inviting children in Jellyfish, Turtles and Octopus to come dressed in clothes that reflect their personality and interests. For example, if your child is very sporty and active they might come dressed in their football clothes. We invite you to be as creative as you like and look forward to seeing how your child expresses themselves through their clothing!

<u>Year 4 Sleepover:</u> On Thursday 20th September, Year 4 children have the chance to sleepover in school! 'Adventures Into' will be leading a fantastic survival themed sleepover, with activities such as archery, fire making and pitching tents. The aim is for our pupils across both campuses to get involved in teamwork and experience camping outdoors.

Pupils will spend the night in tents on the grass at the back of school. They will eat their evening meal together and breakfast, then take part in further activities in the morning.

We still have limited places available. The cost of the residential sleep over is £21 per child. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, the amount payable is £5.25. If your child is not in receipt of Free School Meals but has been previously, the amount payable is £10.50.
