<u>Polite request:</u> In the interest of the safety of all our children, please do not cut through the hall after you have dropped off your children at 9am or picked them up at 3.30pm. Thank you for your support in this matter.

Holidays and leave of absence in school term time: *Please* inform us if you are taking your child out of school during term time as we have a duty of care to find out where a child is if they are not attending school; it also prevents unnecessary phone calls, texts and home visits. All applications for a leave of absence must be made in writing, on the form provided by school.

A leave of absence request shall not be granted in term time unless there are exceptional reasons, irrespective of the child's overall attendance. Only the Head Teacher or designate (not the Local Authority) may authorise such a request. Holidays are not considered as an exceptional circumstance and will be recorded as unauthorised.

Where a parent takes a leave of absence to which the application was refused or takes a leave of absence where no application was made, School will request a penalty notice to be issued by the Local Authority. The penalty notice will be issued to each parent of the individual child.
