<u>Hedgehogs, Owls, Squirrels and Rabbits:</u> Similar to the ever popular Feedback Fridays in EYFS, KS1 would like to invite you to come and see what they have been up to during their 'Telling Tales' topic!. On **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> October** from 3pm you are welcome to come into our classrooms and have a look with your child at the work they have been doing. This is a great opportunity for you to see all the exciting things they have been learning about. The children have worked really hard and are proud of their work so please come along. We look forward to seeing you!

**Key Stage 2 children:** All KS2 children in Years 3,4,5 had an extra assembly this morning to remind them of our expectations for their work and conduct whilst in school. Some poor behaviour is starting to impact negatively on lesson time and break time. The children all know the school rules and we ask for parents' support in ensuring your child follows these rules. The children have been informed what sanctions will be in place should they continue make poor choices. This will involve missed breaktimes, afterschool detentions or you may be asked to come into school to meet the teacher, phase leader, Assistant Head or Head of School.

<u>Goose Fair Menu – Thursday 4th October:</u> Look out for the flyer on Monday with the menu for our Goose Fair themed menu next Thursday. All children in Foundation and KS1 will be ordered a school meal under the universal infant free school meals scheme.

Nursery full time children and KS2 children - the cost for a dinner is £1.95 unless your child is entitled to free school meals. Children who attend Nursery full time and KS2 who are eligible for free school meals will also have a school meal ordered for them. Children will be able to pick their option during morning registration on Thursday 4th October.

It would be fantastic to see as many children as possible enjoying the food we freshly prepare and cook at school. Please inform the school office no later than Wednesday 3rd October if your child does not want a school meal next Thursday and will be bringing a packed lunch in from home. Thank you.

Year 4: There are still some places available on the PGL residential next March. If your child is interested in coming please come to the office or speak to your child's class teacher.

<u>Year 3 Whitby Residential – 15<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> May:</u> Children in year 3 have the opportunity to attend a residential trip to Whitby between 15th-17<sup>th</sup> May 2019. The trip offers 2 nights full accommodation and board at YHA Whitby. Over the course of this 3 day trip there will be many activities on offer such as exploring the local seaside, a tour of the town and Whitby Abbey and the opportunity to explore local wildlife through crabbing, rock–pooling and fossil hunting.

The total cost of the trip will be £132 per pupil which includes 2 nights accommodation, full board, transport and a wealth of activities during our stay. To secure a place for your child (these are limited to 35 children and allocated on a first come first served basis) we require a £20 non-refundable deposit. This will then be deducted from the total balance. If your child has received free school meals over the past six years, the total cost of the trip will be £33 and children who are in receipt of the Pupil Premium Grant will be £66. If you would like your child to have a place complete and return the slip below, with your non-refundable deposit.

Further information will be available at our Whitby Q&A session on **Monday 1st October** at 3.30pm in Pelicans classroom. This will give you an opportunity to speak to Mrs Abasspour and ask any questions you may have about the trip.
