# Nursery: Applying for a 30 hours placement

We are continuing to offer 30-hour places for eligible children who have their 4th birthday between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019. We would like to encourage parents who want to take up a 30 hours place in the Spring term to apply now- and no later than the end of November, to have their application processed in good time. Applications and eligibility checks should be made via the Childcare Choices website (www.childcarechoices.gov.uk). If you application is successful, please can I advise you to contact the school office to validate your 11-digit code and to reserve a place. You will also need to complete a declaration form and bring along with you, your child's birth certificate and your National Insurance number. A confirmation letter will be sent out to you to confirm your child's place.



Reminder: Year 1 Light Night! As part of our pledge to enable children to access enrichment activities beyond the normal school day, we are offering the Year 1 children an exciting 'Light Night'. Children, who are in the Nursery and Years 3 and 4 unless entitled to Free School Meals, will need to pay for school dinners.
