Peacocks, Eagles and Pelicans Creswell Crags Trip: On Wednesday 23rd January 2019 Peacocks, Eagles and Pelicans will be visiting Creswell Crags. This trip will support our next topic – Rock 'n' Roll.

Creswell Crags are prehistoric caves in Worksop, Nottingham. During the visit children will partake in a range of activities including a Cave Tour, Survival Skills and Art of the Ancients.

To ensure that we arrive at Creswell Crags by 10am, we need to leave school at 8:45am therefore we are asking for children to be in school by 8:30am. We hope to return by 4pm, depending on traffic but we will keep you updated on the day.
