Many thanks for your continued support and co-operation during a very busy Autumn Term.

<u>Trips and Fundraising:</u> Your attendance and generosity at our Winter Fairs are very much appreciated. I am very pleased to confirm that we raised a total of £1,837 in profit. As ever, this money will be used to continue to help subsidise trips for all classes each term.

Our school fund, made up of monies from such events as our Summer and Winter Fairs have supported the following this term:

Y1/2 played host to Hobgoblin Theatre 'The Greatest Fairy Tale Ever Told' to support the Telling Tales topic at a cost of £725 and this week have had Toy workshops in each class as part of the Toys topic at a cost of £1,680. School fund has met all of the costs (£2,405) for these 2 wonderful opportunities.

Y3/4 had Bricks Four Kidz spend half a day in each class as part of their Incredible Inventions topic. School paid for all of this at a cost of £950

Y5/6 Trip to Cadbury World linked to the Mayans topic; school contributed £1,300 to this trip so that the cost to parents/carers was just £5 per pupil

The above experiences are an integral part of our curriculum at Heathfield and we are proud to be able to continue such a commitment to enrich our children's experiences and support their learning. I will share with you in the Spring Term how your monies have supported experiences for our EYFS children.

<u>Performances:</u> It was fantastic to see so many friends and family at our 2 Key Stage 1 Productions. Performing to a packed hall was clearly an enjoyable experience for our delightful pupils. Once again, KS1 confirmed that Heathfield really does have the 'R' Factor!

<u>Choir</u>: I would also like to take this opportunity to thank the school choir, and Miss Dickson and Mrs West for their leadership and development of this rich talent. Our combined choirs performed at the Nottingham Albert Hall for Christmas in the City. In addition, the Scotland Road Choir sang at Basford Library for the Sherriff and local community; and at Saint Mary's Church for the Lord Mayor's Carol Service. I have since had a stream of feedback about how magnificent the children both behaved and performed.
