


The club will finish at 4:30 and children who would like to attend will need a drink and their PE kit for the session.



<u>New Menus:</u> Your child will today receive a copy of the new school dinner menu, which will start from Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> April. Don't forget that all children in our Reception and KS1 classes are eligible under the Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme to have a free school meal.

Children, who are in the Nursery and Years 3, 4 and 5 unless eligible to Free School Meals, will need to pay for school dinners. The current price is £1.95 per meal meaning that the weekly cost is £9.75.
