Heathfield Scholastic Book Fair: Next Week (Tuesday, Thursday, Friday)



Just a reminder that the Summer term Scholastic Book fair will be coming to Heathfield. To launch the fair, we will be hosting a **'Camp out with a Book' event** on Tuesday 30th April, straight after school in the hall. Staff will be sharing some of their favourite books and recommended reads from the fair. Juice and biscuits will be served and we will leave out plenty of picnic rugs or mats for you to sit on to listen to stories shared by staff

as well as read a selection of books with your own child. Everyone that takes part in this launch event will receive a stamp on their rainbow reading challenge card (remember to bring it along!) and we will also offer **£1 off** every book sold, using the World Book Day Vouchers. We hope to see many of you there!

Peacocks Swimming: Peacocks class will be going swimming on Monday afternoons, beginning this coming Monday, 29th April. Children will be travelling by bus and will be arriving back to school for **3.30pm**. It is important that your child wears the correct clothing as otherwise the pool will refuse to let them swim; this is a full one-piece swimming costume for girls and swimming trunks that are not baggy and don't have pockets for boys. Please also send them with any long hair tied up, no jewellery or earrings and a towel.

Hathersage Year 2 Trip – July 2019: For those children who are already attending the residential to Hathersage in Derbyshire, please could you ensure all payments for the Hathersage residential trip are made in full no later than **Friday 14th June** as we will need to pay the balance of the trip to the hostel.

School Photo payment deadline: If you would like your child's school class photo all orders need to be in by Tuesday 30th April. Thank you.

PE Kits reminder: All children from F2 to Y5 should bring a spare change of clothes into school for PE. This should include a t-shirt, shorts/tracksuit bottoms and trainers/plimsolls. As the weather begins to improve we would also suggest a hat for sunny days. Children should not be wearing any jewellery on these days.
