<u>School Health drop in</u>: On <u>Tuesday 11th June</u>, School Health will be in school for a drop in session between 8:30am and 9:15am. If you would like to come and speak to them they will be available in the small meeting room across from the school office.

<u>Year 2 Hathersage Residential:</u> If your child has a place on the Year 2 Hathersage residential that is happening between 10th and 12th July full payment for this needs to be made no later than Friday 14th June. Thank you.

There will also be an information meeting for parents of all children taking part in Hathersage 2019 on **Wednesday 12th June at 3:30pm**, in the Hedgehogs classroom. It is important that all parents, carers and their children attend this meeting as additional information will be distributed, such as clothing requirement lists and consent forms, plus it is an opportunity to re-iterate to the children our residential behaviour policy.

<u>Year 4 in 2020:</u> In March this year, we had a fantastic time at PGL Adventure camp in Lincolnshire and have booked to return on **Wednesday 18th March and returning on Friday 20th March 2020.**

If you would like to reserve a place for your child please fill in the reply slip attached and return to school with a £20 deposit before **Thursday 13th June**. The £20 deposit is NON-REFUNDABLE should they decide that they no longer want, or are not able to attend.

<u>School Holidays 2019-2020:</u> Attached to this newsletter is the school holidays calendar including INSET days for the new academic year, 2019/2020. Copies will also be available from the school office from next week.

<u>Holidays and leave of absence in school term time:</u> Please inform us if you are taking your child out of school during term time as we have a duty of care to find out if they are not attending school: it also prevents unnecessary phone calls, texts and home visits. All applications must be made in writing, on the form provided by school.

A leave of absence request shall not be granted unless there are exceptional circumstances. Irrespective of a child's overall attendance. Only the Head Teacher or designate (not the local authority) may authorise such a request. Holidays are not considered as exceptional circumstances and will not be recorded as authorised. When a parent takes a leave of absence to which an application was refused, takes a leave of absence where no application was made or school suspects that a family has been on holiday whilst suggesting to the school another reason of absence, school will request a penalty notice to be issued by the Local Authority. The penalty notice will be issued to each parent of each individual child.

Please note: absences of 3 or more days will require medical documentation to be authorised and may result in a home visit. Attending family celebrations and weddings abroad will be considered as taking a holiday during term time.
