Sports Day: Unfortunately, due to the weather this week we had to postpone our KS1 and KS2 Sports Day. The forecast is very mixed for the next couple of weeks so we will try and reschedule for the following dates:

- 9:30am on Thursday 27th June for KS1 Hedgehogs, Owls, Squirrels and Rabbits
- 9:30am on Tuesday 2nd July for KS2 Peacocks, Eagles, Pelicans and Leopards

This year Kersall Drive will stay on site and use our own sports field. You are welcome to come and cheer on the children. The children will need to have a full PE kit with them including suitable shorts/tracksuit bottoms, t-shirt (not vest top) and trainers.

We were able to have our EYFS Sports Day today and the children in Jellyfish, Turtles and Octopus classes had lots of fun. Well done to all of our winners and runners up and for all of the children who showed their potential talents. We could have Olympians one day!

Eagles Swimming: As part of the school's PE curriculum, Eagles class will be taking swimming lessons each Monday afternoon until the end of term. **They will be back at school for 3:30pm.** Please can you make sure that your child is provided with the following equipment -

- A swimming costume for girls (MUST be a one piece costume)
- Trunks for boys (not shorts-no pockets allowed!)
- A towel
- Bobble to tie long hair back

Please note that children will not be allowed to swim if they are not wearing the appropriate swimwear. Children are **not** permitted to wear any jewellery whilst swimming and are to only bring goggles if we have written permission from a parent/carer.

Reminder: Year 1 and 2 Yorkshire Wildlife Park Trip – Tuesday 2nd July (Hedgehogs, Owls, Squirrels

and Rabbits) Children in KS1 will be visiting Yorkshire Wildlife Park on **Tuesday 2**nd **July**. Children will need to be at school at normal time and will be back at school at approximately 4:15pm. All children will need to bring drinks, lunch and snacks in a backpack that they can carry and a sunhat and waterproof jacket. If you would like your child to have a school provided packed lunch please state this on the reply slip attached.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £4:00, as the rest of expenses will be paid by school. Please let your child's teacher know if you are able to support on this trip. If you have not yet returned your reply slips, please can this be brought back by Tuesday 25th June. Thank you.

<u>Reminder: Year 3 Trip to Green's Windmill:</u> The Peacocks and Eagles will be going together on a trip to Green's Windmill in Sneinton on **Wednesday 26th June.** We will be leaving school at 10:00 am and travelling by tram into the city centre. We will visit the windmill and the science centre and will have our packed lunches whilst on our trip. Please ensure your child wears appropriate footwear and hats /suncream /coat as we will be out and about for most of the day. A rucksack for their packed lunch is also needed.

Reminder: Leopards Tie Dye Activity: As part of the Year 5/6 topic on colour, the children will be creating tie dye t-shirts. We will be supplying all pupils with a t-shirts and the dyes to create these, however in order to cover some of the cost, we politely request a donation of £1.00. This can be handed to class teachers or the office. We really appreciate your support with our fantastic enrichment opportunities.

Holidays and leave of absence in school term time: Please inform us if you are taking your child out of school during term time as we have a duty of care to find out if they are not attending school: it also prevents unnecessary phone calls, texts and home visits. All applications must be made in writing, on the form provided by school.

A leave of absence request shall not be granted unless there are exceptional circumstances. Irrespective of a child's overall attendance. Only the Head Teacher or designate (not the local authority) may authorise such a request. Holidays are not considered as exceptional circumstances and will not be recorded as authorised. When a parent takes a leave of absence to which an application was refused, takes a leave of absence where no application was made or school suspects that a family has been on holiday whilst suggesting to the school another reason of absence, school will request a penalty notice to be issued by the Local Authority. The penalty notice will be issued to each parent of each individual child. Please note: absences of 3 or more days will require medical documentation to be authorised and may result in a home visit.

Attending family celebrations and weddings abroad will be considered as taking a holiday during term time.
