<u>Seahorses and Dolphins Sports Day:</u> EYFS will be having their annual sports day on Friday 21st June. Parents are invited to come and watch from 2pm. The event will take place on the playground at our Scotland Road Campus. Parents will enter school via the gates to the school playground. Please ensure your child has their P.E. kit and has a pair of trainers or plimsolls. Nursery children are invited to come in their sports clothes on this day. Morning nursery children are invited back with an adult to join in the fun.

<u>School Holidays 2019-2020:</u> Attached to this newsletter is the school holidays calendar including INSET days for the new academic year, 2019/2020. Copies will also be available from the school office from next week.



<u>Holidays and leave of absence in school term time:</u> Please inform us if you are taking your child out of school during term time as we have a duty of care to find out if they are not attending school: it also prevents unnecessary phone calls, texts and home visits. All applications must be made in writing, on the form provided by school.

A leave of absence request shall not be granted unless there are exceptional circumstances. Irrespective of a child's overall attendance. Only the Head Teacher or designate (not the local authority) may authorise such a request. Holidays are not considered as exceptional circumstances and will not be recorded as authorised. When a parent takes a leave of absence to which an application was refused, takes a leave of absence where no application was made or school suspects that a family has been on holiday whilst suggesting to the school another reason of absence, school will request a penalty notice to be issued by the Local Authority. The penalty notice will be issued to each parent of each individual child.

Please note: absences of 3 or more days will require medical documentation to be authorised and may result in a home visit.

Attending family celebrations and weddings abroad will be considered as taking a holiday during term time.



Nursery notice - Are you eligible for a 30 hours placement?: We will be continuing to offer 30-hour places from September 2019 for children who have their 4th birthday between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020. If you wish to apply for a 30-hour place please apply via the Childcare Choices website (www.childcarechoices.gov.uk) and bring your 11-digit eligibility code, your national insurance number and your child's birth certificate to complete an application at the school office. Please ensure you have completed the process by Friday 28th June.

A confirmation letter will be sent to parents to confirm a 30-hour placement ready for September 2019.

<u>Midday Supervisor Vacancies:</u> Come and join our team! We currently have Midday Supervisor vacancies across both campuses to work one hour and 25 minutes per day with an hourly rate of £9 per hour. If you or anyone you know is interested in these positions please collect an application form from either school office. Completed application forms should be returned to the school office as soon as possible.



<u>Heathfield is a Nut Free Zone</u>: We now have children within our school that have nut allergies, even the aroma of nuts can generate fits or the need for medical attention. To avoid this we are asking that if your child brings a packed lunch, either to eat during lunch time at school or to eat whilst out on a school trip, that you do not include nut-based foods or foods made from any nuts in their packed lunch. This includes things like Nutella chocolate spread. Thank you for your consideration.
