Parrots, Toucans, Flamingos, Lions, Tigers, Jaguars Sports Day:

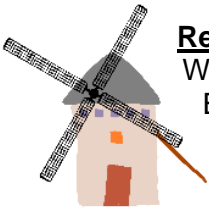
