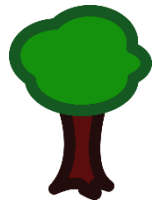

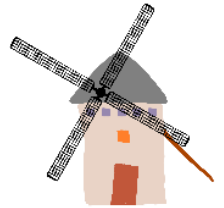


**Reminder, Dolphins:** Dolphin class will be visiting Vernon Park on the morning of Thursday 4th July. **Foxes, Badgers and Hares Trip:** A reminder that this term the children in Key Stage One will be visiting Yorkshire Wildlife Park as part of their continuing Science work linked to different types of animals, their characteristics and their habitats. The trip will take place on **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July** and travel will be by double decker bus.

**We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £4:00**, as the rest of the £7:50 admission fee and £8:00 travel expenses per child will be paid by school funds from the money raised by fund-raising activities.
