Y3 new Peacocks Swimming: After the summer holidays, Peacocks class will be going swimming on a Monday afternoon with Miss Hunt. This will start from Monday 9th September. Children will be travelling by bus and will be arriving back to school for **3.30pm**. It is important that your child wears the correct clothing as otherwise the pool will refuse to let them swim; this is a full one-piece swimming costume for girls and swimming trunks that are not baggy and don't have pockets for boys. Please also send them with any long hair tied up, no jewellery or earrings and a towel.

PE Kit Expectations: A reminder that our policy from September will be for all children to wear a plain white t-shirt, navy shorts/jogging bottoms/leggings and a black jumper/hoodie. All kit needs labelling and it should remain in school all week. Please support us with this. Thank you.

School Dinner Price Increase: A reminder that there will be a price increase from Tuesday 3rd September 2019 from £1.95 to £2.15 per meal for school dinners. This means that the weekly cost will now rise to £10.75.

Children who are in Reception and KS1 from September 2019 will get the Universal Free School Meal entitlement. This is currently available to them until the end of Year 2. Children who are in years 3, 4, 5 and 6 from September 2019, unless entitled to Free School Meals, will need to pay for school dinners. Please send dinner money in for the week ensuring that your child's account remains a week in credit at all times.

Contact details: Please make sure that if you change any of your contact details including your work telephone number that you let the school office know as soon as possible. Should we need to contact you in an emergency we need to have the most up to date information to ensure we can get you as quickly as possible. If any details also change for any other emergency contacts that we hold on your child's records you just also make us aware of this as soon as possible. Thank you.

Afternoons – 3:15pm prompt please (gates open at 3:05pm)

- EYFS no change
- Year 1 will be dismissed from the front playground. Parents are asked to stay behind the line on the playground to allow the classes to be brought to you.
- Year 2 will be dismissed from the classroom doors at the back of school.
- Year 3 will be dismissed from the door near the carpark onto the Foundation yard.
- Year 4 will be dismissed from the back door onto the back playground.
- Year 5/6 will be brought out to the front playground from the side door. Parents are asked to stay behind the line on the playground to allow the classes to be brought to you. This will avoid congestion near the side gate.
