<u>Current Year 3's Sleepover:</u> On Thursday 19th September 2019, there will be a Year 4 sleepover in school! 'Into Adventure' will be leading a fantastic survival themed sleepover, with activities such as archery, fire making and pitching tents.

The aim is for our pupils across both campuses to get involved in
