<u>School Meal Price Increase Reminder</u>: From Tuesday 3rd of September 2019 the price of a school meal will rise from £1.95 to £2.15 per meal. This means the weekly cost will rise to £10.75.

Children who are in Reception and KS1 from September 2019 will get the Universal Free School Meal entitlement. This is currently available to them until the end of Year 2.

Children who are in years 3, 4, 5 and 6 from September 2019, unless entitled to Free School Meals, will need to pay for school dinners. Please send dinner money in for the week ensuring that your child's account remains a week in credit at all times.
