New Staff: Also having a great first week are our new members of staff. Miss Willey is the new Pumas teacher in Year 5/6, Mrs Comber is now the Eagles teacher in Year 3, Miss Tunstall is the new Falcons class teacher in Year 4 and Miss Perkins joins KS1 in Year 2 with the Rabbits. We also have a new Teaching Assistant, Miss Evans who will be working across school but is based in KS2 and Miss Redmile has become a permanent member of staff in F1. Finally we have a new Safeguarding Officer called Mrs Dyer. You will see her at the gate in the morning. Mrs Dyer is joining our team to support with any safeguarding concerns, make links with families and to monitor Attendance and Punctuality at Kersall Drive.

<u>Parking outside of school:</u> Kersall Drive is a busy thoroughfare and so illegal parking can make it a dangerous road for our children. Please ensure that if parking on Kersall Drive near school you are considerate to the residents on the street and also to other road users, parents and most importantly, our children. Please do not park across residents' driveways or on the yellow zig zag lines outside of school. Thank you

<u>PE Kit:</u> Thank You to all of you who have ensured your child is wearing the correct PE kit in school. The children look very smart and part of 'Team Heathfield'! T-shirts should be plain white t-shirts and shorts/joggers should be black or navy blue. All kit needs labelling and it should remain in school all week.

<u>Peacocks Swimming:</u> Peacocks class will be going swimming on a Monday afternoon with Miss Hunt. This will start from **Monday 9th September**. Children will be travelling by bus and will be arriving back to school for **3.30pm**. It is important that your child wears the correct clothing as otherwise the pool will refuse to let them swim; this is a full one-piece swimming costume for girls and swimming trunks that are not baggy and don't have pockets for boys. Please also send them with any long hair tied up, no jewellery or earrings and a towel.

EYFS 'Wheels Day' Friday 20th September (Jellyfish, Turtles and Octopus) As part of our 'Out and About' topic children are invited to bring their bike or scooter to school on **Friday 20th September**. The children will be learning all about road safety and exploring the school grounds on their set of wheels. Please ensure your child's bike **and helmet** or scooter are clearly labelled with their name. Thank you.

ALDI Kit for School stickers: If you or family members shop in ALDI, please collect the 'Team GB' stickers. The children can bring them in and they will be put on our huge poster in the hall. <u>REMINDER - School Dinner Price Increase:</u> There has been a price increase from £1.95 to £2.15 per meal for school dinners. This means that the weekly cost has now rise to £10.75.

Children who are in Reception and KS1 get the Universal Free School Meal entitlement. This is currently available to them until the end of Year 2. Children who are in years 3, 4, 5 and 6 from September 2019, dinner money in for the week ensuring that your child's account remains a week in credit at all times.

We have always endeavored to make our parents and carers aware that they may be able to claim FREE school meals. If you think that you are eligible for them please come to the school office to pick up a form. Once completed please return this to the office as soon as possible so that we are able to establish whether you are able to claim free school meals. Until your form has been assessed you must still pay for any meals your child has.

<u>Year 5 York Residential Parents' Meeting:</u> There will be meeting for parent/carers of children who are going on the York residential in October. The meeting is on **Monday 16th September at 3.30pm** in the Leopards classroom where Mr Battison will speak about the activities planned and hand out forms that will need to be completed.
