<u>Well done</u> to our classes who have hit our target of 96.5% or above for attendance. All children need to attend school every day but we understand there may be occasions when they are poorly. Any time out of school can have a negative impact on learning and behaviour.

Attendance & punctuality expectations: Our attendance and punctuality expectations are below:

- Both entrance gates are open from 8:30am so you can be on the yard ready for the morning bell to go at 8:45am.
- Parents must inform school, on the day, if your child is going to be late or absent.
- A text will be sent out for unexplained absences, followed up a phone call and a possible home visit if school has not been given a reason of absence.
- All absences of three or more days will need a form of medical documentation in order to be authorised.
- Families with children absent for three or more days may receive an unannounced home visit, even if they have informed the school that their child will be absent this is due to a number of families who have gone on holiday whilst informing the school that their child was absent for another reason.
- Non-attendance and arriving late will initially be addressed by text, followed up by phone calls and may result in more formal attendance meetings if there is little or no improvement.

Please contact **Mrs Dyer** (our Safeguarding and Attendance officer) if you wish to discuss anything that may affect your child's attendance or punctuality. She is usually at the gate or at the office in the morning.

Don't forget: Our FREE Early Birds Breakfast Club runs every day in the hall from 8:15am until the start of



the school day at 8:45am. Parents wishing to use this club are reminded that all children must be in the hall **before 8:30am** so there is enough time for the children to eat and the staff to clear the hall ready for the start of the day. Children should be brought to the hall doors where they will be met by a member of staff to sign in.

REMINDER: EYFS 'Wheels Day' Friday 20th September (Jellyfish, Turtles and Octopus)

As part of our 'Out and About' topic children are invited to bring their bike or scooter to school on **Friday 20th September**. The children will be learning all about road safety and exploring the school grounds on their set of wheels. Please ensure your child's bike or scooter **and helmet** are clearly labelled with their name. Thank you.

European Day of Languages: On **Thursday 26**th **September** we will be celebrating the languages spoken by our school community. Children will take part in different activities in their classes to highlight the importance of learning languages. There will also be an activity sheet for children to complete and this will be sent out with next week's newsletter. <u>Young Voices Choir:</u> Young Voices is back! We will be going to the Sheffield Arena again on Tuesday 14th January 2020 and have lots of work to do to get ready!

Choir will be starting on **Thursdays** from **3:15pm to 4pm** from 19th September and is open to children in **years 3, 4, 5 and 6**. If your child would like to come along, please return the attached audition slip as soon as possible to the office. Mrs West will then hold auditions on Tuesday 17th September, and you will receive a text confirming your child has a place in our choir. If your child was a member last year, they can return without an audition but please still return the slip so we know you are coming!
