<u>Seahorses and Dolphins 'Wheels Day' Friday 20th September:</u> As part of our 'Out and About' topic children are invited to bring their bike or scooter to school on Friday 20th September. The children will be learning all about road safety and exploring the school grounds on their set of wheels. Please ensure your child's bike is clearly labelled with their name. Thank you.



<u>Swimming:</u> Year 3 children in the Toucan class will start swimming next week. The sessions will run from Friday 13th September to Friday 18th October 2019. Please could you ensure that children come to school on these days with a suitable bag, towel, one-piece swimming costume for girls or tight-fitting shorts for

boys without pockets. Earrings must be removed before getting into the pool. Swimming goggles can only be worn if a written note from a parent/carer is given to the class teacher. Any religious bracelets must be covered also (with sweat bands for example). The lessons will be taking part during the school day, with regular collection at 3:30pm.

Autumn Term Choir Rehearsals (KS2 Children only): Choir rehearsals will begin with Miss Dickson on Monday 16th September from 3:30pm – 4:15pm and will continue to be every Monday for the remainder of the term. Please note the revised finishing time. During this term, we will be working towards a number of performances including Young Voices 2020 as well as Christmas events. REMINDER - PE Kit Expectations: A reminder that our policy is for all children to wear a plain white t-shirt, black or navy blue shorts/jogging bottoms/leggings and a black jumper/hoodie. All kit needs labelling and it should remain in school all week. Please support us with this. Thank you.

REMINDER - School Dinner Price Increase: There has been a price increase from £1.95 to £2.15 per meal for school dinners. This means that the weekly cost has now rise to £10.75.

Children who are in Reception and KS1 get the Universal Free School Meal entitlement. This is currently available to them until the end of Year 2. Children who are in years 3, 4, 5 and 6 from September 2019, dinner money in for the week ensuring that your child's account remains a week in credit at all times. We have always endeavored to make our parents and carers aware that they may be able to claim FREE school meals. If you think that you are eligible for them please come to the school office to pick up a form. Once completed please return this to the office as soon as possible so that we are able to establish whether you are able to claim free school meals. Until your form has been assessed you must still pay for any meals your child has.
