Parents' Evening Wednesday 4th **December:** Parents' Evening will be on **Wednesday 4**th **December** from 3:30pm to 7:30pm. This will be a great opportunity to find out how your child is getting on in school and to look at the work and progress they are making. Appointments are made on a first come first served basis so please complete the slip attached or speak to your child's teacher as soon as possible to guarantee the time you want. All parents should attend on this evening or speak to their child's teacher to make alternative arrangements.

F2 – Year 6 Flu Immunisations: The immunization team will be coming into school on **Friday 22**_{nd} **November** to administer the flu vaccine. This year is the first time the vaccine is being offered to all primary school-aged children. The flu vaccine for children is a nasal spray (sprayed into the nose), not an injection. Please see the school office if you have not received a letter with instructions on how to give your consent online. Please complete as soon as you can to ensure your child gets vaccinated. Even if you do not want your child to be vaccinated please complete the online form to let the school health team know.

Winter Fair: On Friday 6th December we will have our annual Winter Fair in the hall from 2pm. There will be a number of stalls and our popular raffle plus our Year 5/6 children will be running a games room during the fair. There are stalls available for a £10 fee. If you are able to donate any prizes for our raffle from your place of work, that would be fantastic.

<u>Y6 Parent SATs Meeting</u>: On Thursday 21_{st} November Mr Battison and Miss Willey will be running a meeting for all Y6 parents to brief you on the Year 6 SATs which will take place in May 2020. The idea of having a meeting so soon into the year is so that you understand how you can help with your child at home and can ask any questions you may have about the tests. There will be booster sessions for some children starting after Christmas so these will also be explained to you. The meeting will start at 3:20pm in Leopards classroom.
