<u>Warwick Castle:</u> We are excited to now be able to share details with you about our upcoming trip to Warwick Castle, to support our new topic for this half term 'The Tudors'. Due to the number of children in the phase, it has been necessary to book the trip over two different dates which are as follows;

Flamingos - Tuesday 19th November Parrots and Toucans – Thursday 21st November

In order to maximise our time at Warwick Castle and for the children to enjoy as many of the activities on offer as possible, will need to leave school at 8am. Therefore, children will need to arrive at school for 7.45am on the day of departure for their class and will return to school for 5.45pm.

As we will be at the castle all day, children will need to bring a packed lunch with them, a mid-morning snack and also plenty to drink, fizzy drinks are not allowed. If your child is in receipt of free school meals and you wish to order a lunch from school, then please indicate on the slip below. Children will also need a thick, waterproof coat as most of the day will be spent outside, along with comfortable waterproof shoes. Children should wear school uniform as normal.

The cost of the trip is £19.50 per child, however we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£5 per child** with the rest of the cost being covered by school. We would be very grateful if permission slips and contributions could be sent to the office as soon as possible. Flu Immunisation:

It is time for your child's yearly flu vaccination! School Years: Reception, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 (children born between 01.09.2008 and 31.08.2015)

Why get your child vaccinated?

It helps keep your child safe from flu. Flu can be a nasty illness and sometimes causes really serious problems. It is a quick and simple nose spray that works the same as a flu jab.

Giving your child the flu spray will stop the spread. This will help keep friends and family safe. Older people and those with illnesses are most at risk if they catch flu from children.

It is free for your child. Flu changes so even if they had it last year they need it again this year. www.nhs.uk/child-flu has more information and tells you which children need the flu jab instead of the nose spray.

How do you let us know you want your child to have the flu vaccination?

What if my child is absent?

If your child is away from school on the day, please contact us to book a clinic appointment. This vaccine is not offered by your GP unless your child is in an at risk group.

If your child becomes wheezy, has a bad attack of asthma, or has started steroid tablets for asthma after you return this form, please contact the School Aged Immunisation Service.



If your child has this vaccination anywhere else, let the team know to stop them getting it again.

REMINDER: Sign up to School Gateway as Heathfield becomes CASHLESS: Thank you to those of you that have signed up and are now using School Gateway to make payments. As we start and become a "cashless" school, all future payments will need to be made via the app, online bank transfer or credit or debit card.



We will **no longer be able to accept cash** payments for dinners, uniforms, trips, residentials or paid breakfast and afterschool clubs. **Please make sure that you download the app**: If you have a smartphone, please download School Gateway from your app store (Android and iPhone). If you do not have a smartphone you can still pay online via the website <u>www.schoolgateway.com</u> The app shows the same information as the website PLUS it saves the school the cost of a text message. **Please follow the following instructions to register and receive your PIN.**

1. Click on "**New User**". Fill in the email address and mobile number and press the "**Send PIN**" button. You will then be sent a new PIN number by text.

2. Enter **PIN** and press "Login" - you will then see a message allowing you to receive notifications from Heathfield.

3. Click on the "**home**" icon and you will have a payment request for dinners, paid clubs, trips, etc. Click on "**My Payments**" and you can then make online payments, and view balances.

If you are unable to register it may be because your details do not match those we have on file for you therefore please contact the school office who will check your details with you. Thank you.

Reminder, Dolphins trip to the Snow Dragon: On Friday 29th November, Dolphins are going to go and see the Snow Dragon at the Lakeside Theatre.
