Head lice: At the moment we have issues throughout the school with head lice. If all children are checked for any signs of head lice, including any eggs and treated then we will hopefully start next

week 'nit free'. Lice are usually found around the hairline or at the roots of the hair – they can make your child very itchy and uncomfortable. Head lice treatment is very effective and can be obtained from chemists and supermarkets. Using the metal combs and conditioner is also a way to remove live head lice but this may not always clear the hair fully of the eggs. We recommend that long hair is tied up to help prevent the spreading of head lice and that hair is checked daily.

School Gateway App: If you have a smartphone, please download School Gateway from your app store (Android and iPhone). If you do not have a smartphone, you can still pay online via the website <u>www.schoolgateway.com</u>. The app shows the same information as the website PLUS it saves the school the cost of a text message.

Please follow the following instructions to register and receive your PIN.

Click on "**New User**". Fill in the email address and mobile number and press the "**Send PIN**" button. You will then be sent a new PIN number by text.

Enter **PIN** and press "Login" - you will then see a message allowing you to receive notifications from Heathfield.

Click on the "**home**" icon and you will have a payment request for dinners, paid clubs, trips, etc. Click on "**My Payments**" and you can then make online payments, and view balances.
