<u>KS1 Trip to Rushcliffe Country Park</u>: On Thursday 26th March children in Hedgehogs, Owls, Squirrels and Rabbits will be going on a trip to Rushcliffe Country Park. We will be leaving school at 9.30am and returning before the end of the school day. Please make sure your child is wearing sensible footwear and warm clothing as it may be very muddy and cold.

<u>Pelicans and Falcons - The Great Orchestra Experiment:</u> Since September, children in Year 4 have been learning to play a stringed instrument as part of the Whole Class Ensemble Tuition programme and so have been invited to play their instrument alongside The Robin Hood and Robin Hood Youth Orchestras at The Nottingham Albert Hall on **Wednesday 25th March.**

We will be travelling to The Albert Hall by tram. The children will need to wear school uniform as usual but will also need to ensure they wear a suitable coat for the journey.


<u>Stop the germs</u>: Please could you demonstrate to your child the importance of good hygiene routines. There are some great handwashing videos on YouTube that use song and rhyme to encourage children to stay germ free.

Encourage your child to wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds ensuring they are rubbing the back of their hands and between their fingers.

At school we are updated daily by Public Health England regarding any actions to take and are doing so accordingly. The main message is to promote good hygiene through hand washing. They also suggest the following:



We are minimising chances of spreading any germs and therefore have decided to turn off the drinking water fountains in the shared areas until further notice. Children should therefore ensure they **bring in their own (named) water bottle** which must be washed properly at home each night.



THANK YOU for your amazing efforts for World Book Day yesterday - the children looked fantastic in their outfits and the staff got involved too! The Mad Hatter's Tea Party had 73 children enjoying their reward for completing the Green challenge and we had 50 children and families join the Quiz after school! Well done to our Foundation children who clearly

know their stories and won most of the prizes on offer with an incredible 33 points for our winning team! & children also won prizes for their bookmark designs and the opportunity to have their design turned into bookmarks for the whole school.



The highlight of the day was our Paired Reading assembly where every children shared a book with someone from another year group which meant we have found some excellent Reading Buddies in our older children who we will be asking to do this more regularly to listen to any children still on Red or Orange.



Remember: Reading is so important and so children should be heard at least 3 times a week - hopefully more.... The children who are not moving through our Rainbow Challenge need parent support.
