**IMPORTANT - Year 6**: If you have not yet received your email confirming your Year 6 child's Secondary school place offer, please try the following instructions:


- Log on to your city council portal account (the same place you made the application) and you will see the decision.

<u>Pelicans and Falcons - The Great Orchestra Experiment:</u> In response to government guidelines and the evolving corona-virus risks, Nottingham Music Hub have made the difficult decision to **postpone** the Year 4 Great Orchestra Experiment, which was to take place on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March. Whilst we are disappointed that we won't be able to attend the event this month, the Music Hub have decided that this was the best decision considering the scale and nature of the event. You will be notified of the new date once this has been confirmed.

<u>Staff news:</u> Miss Weaver will be returning to school next week after her maternity leave and will be working in Year 2 and in Pelicans class. Mrs Baker had her baby girl last week – both are doing well.

**PGL:** Some Y4 children and staff are going to PGL next week. Falcons class will be covered by Ms Martin and Miss Dickens whilst Miss Tunstall is on the residential.

<u>Stop the germs</u>: Please could you demonstrate to your child the importance of good hygiene routines. There are some great handwashing videos on YouTube that use song and rhyme to encourage children to stay germ free.

Encourage your child to wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds ensuring they are rubbing the back of their hands and between their fingers.

At school we are updated daily by Public Health England regarding any actions to take and are doing so accordingly. The main message is to promote good hygiene through hand washing. They also suggest the following:



We are minimising chances of spreading any germs and therefore have decided to turn off the drinking water fountains in the shared areas until further notice. Children should therefore ensure they **bring in their own** (named) **water** bottle which must be washed properly at home each night
