Congratulations to the Jaguars class who won the Attendance League last week and will have £9.89 added to their Bank of Heathfield Account. Well done.

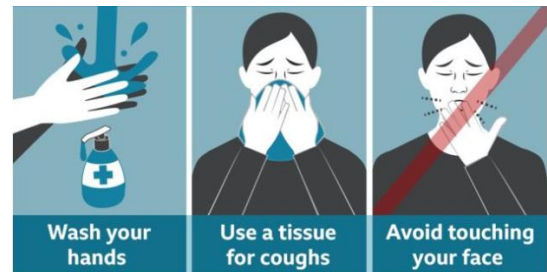

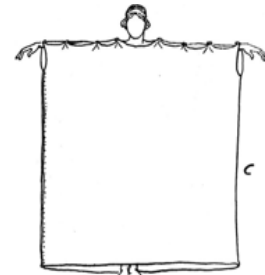
If your child has still not quite completed their Green Certificate and needs a little more time, there will be further chances for them to catch up and get a voucher before the summer holidays.



**Year 6:** If you have not yet received your email confirming your Year 6 child's Secondary school place offer, please try the following instructions

- Log on to their city council portal account (the same place they made the application) and they will see their decision.
- Email: [schooladmissions@nottinghamcity.gov.uk](mailto:schooladmissions@nottinghamcity.gov.uk) and ask for the email to be resent.
- Call the school admission team and ask for the email to be resent - **Please tell parents that decisions cannot be given over the phone due to data and child protection legislation.**
- If the child is a city resident, and they have been made an offer, you will be able to see their destination school on your own admissions portal.
