



#### Outdoor Learning

On the sunny days can you look for shadows outside. Is your shadow tall or short? Can you make your shadow dance? What else is making shadows? If you have some chalk you can try drawing round different shadows.

Can you draw some weather symbols and do your own weather forecast like on JoJo and Gran Gran? Draw them on small bits of paper and then cut them out or ask a grown up to help you.

Or you could record what the weather is like each day and create a diary. We would love to see what you get up to! Don't forget to email your teacher!
