### Reading

If you have any books about animals at home then have a go at reading them, or maybe just a book with an animal in, like the tiger who came to tea or the Gruffalo. See if you can spot any of the red words from this week's bright ideas in the stories and make a record of how many you were able to find.

### **Creative**

Can you have a go at making different animals using play dough, maybe you could look outside and find some leaves, sticks, stones etc for the legs, ears, or various other body parts.
