## Maths

Our numbers of the week are 0 and 1. Can you find different representations of 0 and 1? It could be 1 sock, 1 shoe, an empty container, it could be the numerals 0 and 1. Can you practise writing the numerals? Can you practise counting out different amounts of objects and finding 1 less and 1 more?

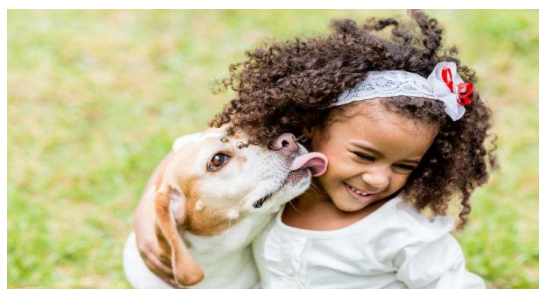
We are also thinking about making patterns this week. Can you find some different objects and put them into a repeating pattern? You can take a photo of your pattern and send it to your teacher.

## Literacy

What pet would you like? Talk about your ideas with an adult.

They can help you to say and write the sentence "I would like a pet...because...." You can draw a picture of your pet and send a picture to your teacher.

The adult can help you to hold your pencil correctly and write your letters correctly too.

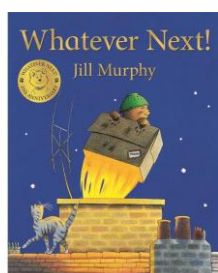
## Our Theme for the Week

## Outdoor Learning



Look outside the window when it is dark or even go on a night time adventure and see if you can see any stars! Can you count them? Can you see the moon? Does it look the same every night or does the sky change?

Talk about what you can see. Try modelling a sentence starter with your child like 'I can see lots of shiny, twinkly stars' and see if they can say a whole sentence too.

## Numbers

Our number of the week is 2. Can you find different representations of 2 around your house? It could be 2 socks; 2 shoes; 2 cars or 2 blocks etc. Can you find the numeral 2 or even write it? Ask your grown up to take a photo of all the different ways of showing 2 and send it to your teacher.

We are also thinking about 2D shapes this week. Can you make a space rocket using different cut out shapes? What shape would you need for the windows? or the top of the rocket?

## Literacy

What do you think you might see in space? Can you create a space picture? You could draw or paint it and even add glitter to the stars!
