



Maths

If you have a dice practice rolling it and seeing what number comes up. Can you do that many hops, jumps or claps? If you don't have a dice you could make one using a building block and adding on sticky dots or simple draw dice images on squares or paper. Soon you will just recognise the number without baying to count!

Outdoor Learning



I hope you have enjoyed completing all the activities for our 'Three Billy Goat's Gruff' theme this week.


How about trying a challenge activity!
