

Set 1 Phonics Home Work Pack

Dear Parents/Carers

This booklet covers some of the sounds that we were working on before lockdown.

Please use these resources to support your child's reading.

Each day work on a new sound and revisit any from previous days. This only needs to take about 10 - 15 minutes. There are 2 books for your child to read to you - please read these a couple of times each over 2 or 3 days.

Glossary

Fred talk – sounding out the word before reading eg. m-a-t mat

Listening to your child read

- Do not read the book aloud before your child reads it to you
- Ask your child to read the Story Green words and the Tricky read words before reading the story
- Encourage your child to sound out the words that they can't read automatically
- Read back each sentence or page to keep the plot moving (your child's energy is going into reading words not the story)
- Keep it light and fun

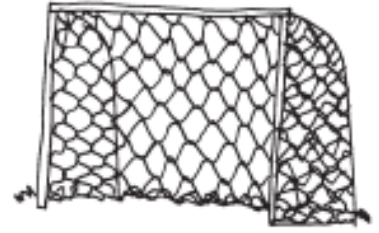

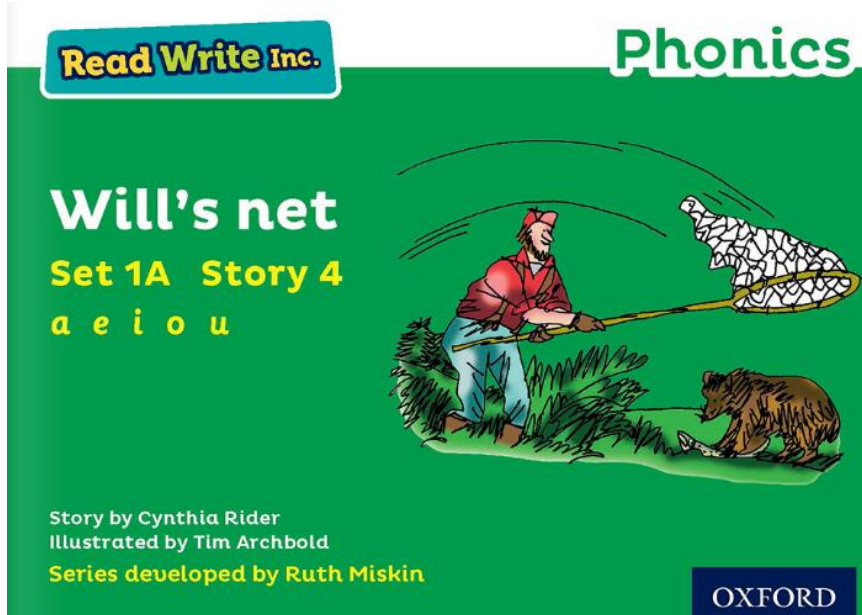

Introduction

Baby bears are called bear cubs. They love to eat fish. Will is angry when a bear cub takes a fish from his pond. So Will decides to catch the bear in his net, but the bear doesn't want to be caught. Let's see what happens.

A **bear** cub got a fish from Will's pond.

"Put it back!"
said Will.



Grrr! went **the** cub ...

and Will ran.



"I'll get that cub!
I'll trap it
in a net,"
said Will.



Will crept back to the pond. Whizz!

Will got the cub in his net.
But the cub went rip, rip, rip!

"Help!" said Will.
"No net!"

Questions to talk about

Ask children to TYP for each question using 'Fastest finger' (FF) or 'Have a think' (HaT).

- p.8 (HaT) How did Will feel about the cub catching a fish in his pond? (Look at the picture to help: pleased/cross/furious.)
- p.9 (FF) What did the cub do?
- p.10 (FF) What did Will decide to do?
How did Will get back to the pond?
- p.11 (HaT) How did Will feel when the cub ripped through the net?
- pp.12-13 (FF) What did he do?

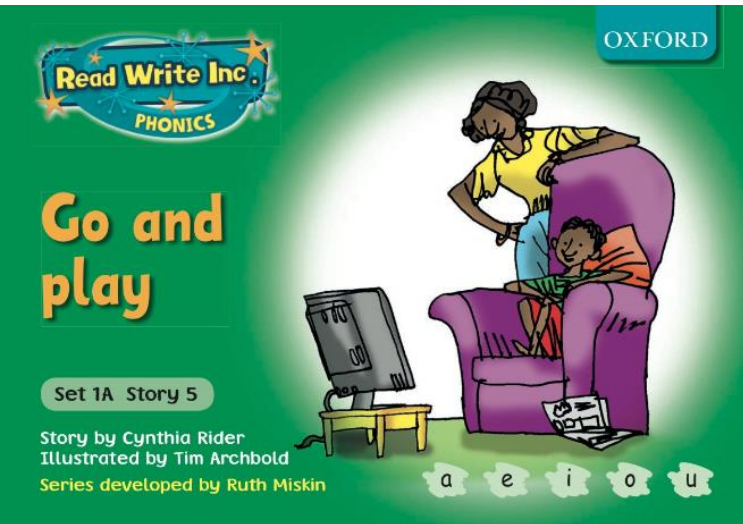

Read the root word first and then with the ending.

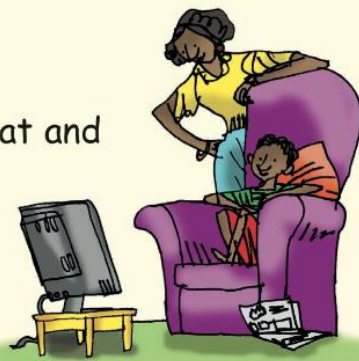
