THANK YOU: We would like to thank you all again for your support with our staggered drop-off and collection arrangements. There is now a steady flow of parents on site which is enabling better social distancing and the one way system is being followed. Please remember if your surname starts with N-Z that your child will still be busy in class until 3:20pm (1pm on Fridays) so do not come any earlier to avoid waiting around on the playground. As Government restrictions on the number of people gathering are being limited again from Monday we ask that you maintain a social distance from people from other households whilst on site.

Kersall Drive Parking: There have been a couple of near misses and one broken wing mirror this week with the amount of cars trying to park so close to the entrance to school. Kersall Drive gets extremely busy so please be mindful of not mounting the kerb when children are walking past, keeping the yellow zig zag lines free of parked cars and not dropping your children off in the middle of the road. We would hate for an accident to happen because of unsafe road use.

<u>Scotland Road confirmed case:</u> There has been a confirmed Covid-19 case at our Scotland Road Campus. Public Health England have been informed. **Kersall Drive remains unaffected**. We are operating as separate campuses. Kersall Drive will remain OPEN TO ALL PUPILS AS USUAL next week.

This form must be completed every week if a place is required.



This club is only open to single parent/carer working families or families where both parent/carers work on a Friday afternoon. For your child to remain at school on a Friday afternoon in our Phase Rainbow Clubs, we need to see proof that you have to work and do not have alternative childcare.

The children in the Phase Rainbow Clubs will have opportunity to do homework, read with an adult to get a stamp on their Rainbow Reading cards as well as a variety of other craft activities, games and sports. School will remain open for staff and the Afterschool Club will run as normal until 6pm.

You will have the option to collect your child from Rainbow Club at 2pm or 3:30pm only. Please choose the time best suited to your needs. Please use the main gate to collect your child from Rainbow Club – they will be brought out to you at your chosen collection time. Please don't collect between these times as it disturbs the children's activities and interrupts the office from working.

<u>Flu Vaccination:</u> Children will be coming home today with a letter and leaflet about the flu vaccination which has been booked in for the afternoon on **Thursday 12th November**. It is for all children in years Reception, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6. You will need to complete an on line consent form for each child which can be found by going to https://www.nottinghamshireimmunisations.co.uk/Forms/Flu.

The code for the Kersall Drive Campus is **NG122442S** and forms need to be completed by **30th September 2020** to ensure your child gets vaccinated. Even if you do not want your child to be vaccinated please complete the form to let the immunisation team know.

<u>PARENT LITE APP:</u> As a school, we always need to ensure that your contact details and your child/children's information is up to date and accurate should we need to contact you for any reason. To support this we have a new convenient way for you to access, review and request changes to the data held on you and your children.

An activation email for you to access this new parent app at your own convenience via smartphone, tablet or PC has been sent out this week. *Please note that your activation email is unique to you and should not be used by anyone else. Your activation email will expire after 14 days if it is not used, please contact your school if you require a replacement after this date.* If you have not received this please contact the school office so that we can check we have your correct email address on our system.

Getting started with the SIMS Parent Lite App

- 1. We will send you an activation email to the email address we have on record for you, simply click on the link from your tablet, PC or smartphone to activate your account
- 2. You can then login using your normal **Facebook, Twitter**, **Google** or **Microsoft** username and password
- 3. From your smartphone or tablet, download the app from the Google Play or Apple App store search for **SIMS Parent Lite**
- **4.** From a PC or Windows phone, login online at www.sims-parent.co.uk

REMINDER School Gateway App: In order for you to pay for anything at school you need to download and sign into the School Gateway App. This is where your messages from school will appear too. If you have already signed up but your app is not working or you are unable to log in, we advise you uninstall the app and then try downloading it again or call the school office who can advise you.

Home Learning: If for any reason your child is self-isolating their teacher will email work packs out to be completed while they are absent. Please also refer back to our Home Learning page on the school website for links to useful websites and homework activities.
