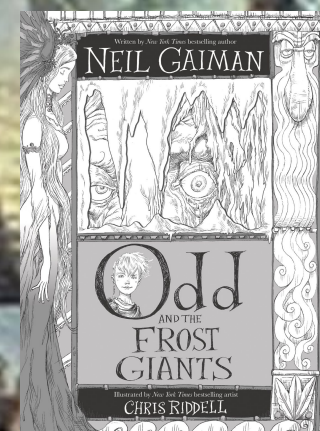

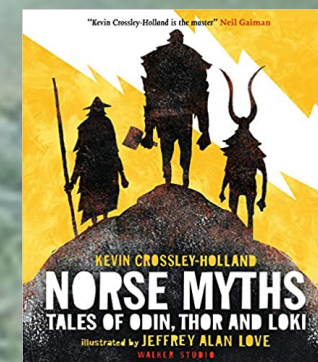
Art	Detailed sketches of viking patterns and weaving paper to form a sculpture.
