reflecting on her life and the once in a lifetime event which has been unfolding over the last week. <u>Change of Date Year 3 & 4 Welcome meeting</u>: Tuesday 20th September 2022 Parents/Carers of children in the Flamingos, Toucans and Parrots are invited to the Year 3 and 4 Welcome Meeting. You will find out more about routines, curriculum, trips and frequently asked questions and will last about half an hour. <u>Times Tables Rockstars and Numbots Launch Day – Fancy Dress</u>: On Friday 23rd September 2022, we will be having a Numbots/TTRockstar launch day! They are apps children will use in school, and at home, to help their number fluency. On the day we will make sure all children have their logins and usernames and will be reminded how to use the apps. The children will then have their login to use at home and regular practise will boost your child's number fluency.

We hope you will help us get into the spirit by sending your child dressed up as a Robot or Rockstar to celebrate - the crazier the better!

What's Been Happening in School:

This week Year 1 and 2 started their Telling Tales topic. In English we have been looking at the story 'Little Red Riding Hood'. Each class created a text map to practise retelling the story. The children are now starting to practise writing the story. In Maths Year 1 practised finding 1 more and 1 less than a given Year number. Year 2 have been consolidating their work on 2-digit numbers. They have been writing addition 1&2 number sentences and writing the numbers as words. In Topic, the children enjoyed a fairy tale performance by Hobgoblin Theatre Company. They also enjoyed learning about the history of fairy tales. The children have also been learning more about the Queen and creating some artwork. Year 3 & 4 have started their new topic 'Incredible Inventions'. In English we have started our new book 'The Iron Man' and have been building up some vocabulary ready to write a character description next week. In Maths, Y3 have continued to work on place value. Year 4 have been counting in 25s and 100s and Year 3&4 estimating the position of different numbers on a number line. On Friday, the children have been recapping their shape knowledge. In Topic, we have been learning about different famous inventions and their inventors. The children have also created some artwork of the Queen and learning more about her life. Y5&6 have started reading their new text for our Planet Earth topic – The Last Wild by Piers Torday. By using the front cover and the blurb, we have made predictions and inferences about what the text will be about. The children have considered the strength of meaning of vocabulary and how this can represent settings and characters. In Y5 maths, we have learnt how to read and write numbers up to 1,000,000. The Year children have applied their prior knowledge of place value to answer reasoning and fluency questions. In Y6 5&6 maths, the children have compared and rounded numbers up to 1,000,000. In their Friday Maths lesson, they have recapped plotting and reading coordinates. In Science, the children have classified living things into plants, animals and microorganisms and understand the definition of each. In Geography, we have used atlases to identify human and physical features on a World map.

This team is led by our Deputy Head and Inclusion Lead Mrs Abasspour, and supported by our SENDCo Mrs Griffiths and our Assistant SENDCo Miss Gell.



Mrs Abasspour has been a class teacher and phase leader at Heathfield for many years, having experience across Key Stage One and Key Stage Two. This year she will be based across both campuses throughout the week and you will be able to contact her on either of the school office telephone numbers.

Mrs Griffiths is in her seventh year at Heathfield, and was previously a class teacher and the SENDCo at Kersall Drive. <u>Parent Lite App</u>: As a school, we always need to ensure that your contact details and your child/children's information is up to date and accurate should we need to contact you for any reason. <u>Reception to Year 6 Flu Vaccinations – Tuesday 4th October:</u> It is now time for your child's yearly flu nasal spray! The free seasonal flu spray is offered to all children and young people in Reception and Year 1-Year 6 classes. Even if your child received this last year it is recommended, they have it again this year or they won't be protected. It is more important than ever to reduce the number of those becoming ill with flu this winter to help protect them and the NHS.

You must complete one online consent form for each of your children. It is important every child has a completed form which states if you would like them to receive the flu vaccination spray or not. The online consent form can be found through this link <u>https://www.nottinghamshireimmunisations.co.uk/Forms/Flu</u> The school code for Scotland Campus is NG122442S. Online consent will close at 3pm the working day before vaccination session.

If you decide you want to withdraw consent you must email sais@nottshc.nhs.uk at least 24 hours before our school vaccination session is due. The nasal spray may not be suitable for some children, for more information visit www.nhs.uk/child-flu or pick up a leaflet from the school office.

Please note: If any of the following happen after completing this form you must contact the School Aged Immunisation Service: if your child becomes wheezy, has a bad attack of asthma, has started steroid tablets for asthma or has had this vaccination anywhere else.
