

EYFS

This Week...

F2 have learnt to retell a simplified version of Someone Swallowed Stanley by Sarah Roberts. We have performed our retellings to each other and written our own simplified versions. Please ask us to retell our stories at home as we are rather expert at it!

In F1, we have begun learning all out cake inspired by the story Cake by Sue Hendra. We have tried some different types of cakes, thought about when you might eat cake and designed our own cakes!

F2 will be learning about different environmental activists and F1 will be preparing for a party at the end of the week where we will make our own cake to celebrate!

KS₁

This Week...

in Key stage 1 we have been writing up our Non-Fiction writing all about Dinosaurs! We have created our own fact-files and we think we are now experts at dino facts! During maths in Year 1, we have been consolidating and assessing our learning on both fractions and position and direction. In Year 2 we have been continuing to focus on fractions. We have been comparing fractions and looking at the relationships between 1 half and 2 quarters. In art this week we have been painting our clay dinosaurs! They look fantastic and we can't wait to share them with you. In geography we have continued to look at oceans and continents and even begun to look at the animals that might live there.

Next week...

It is Book Week! Each class will be focussing on their own chosen book and completing lots of exciting activities linked to the story. We thoroughly enjoy exploring a range of books and this gives us the chance to share our books with our friends in different classes.

Year 3/4

This Week... We have been busy filming our Virtual Reality films set in another dimension! There are class assemblies coming up (please check the up and coming dates) where you will be able to see the films. In Maths, Year 3 are learning about adding and subtracting amounts of money. Many are finding this tricky as they haven't handled coins themselves. If you are able to use coins at home practicing the denominations with your child, please do! In Year 4, we are learning about decimals and partitioning amounts. In Science, we have been busy learning all about circuits using batteries, wires and lightbulbs. We are also learning how to add switches too, understanding how to increase the light bulb's brightness.

In our last week we will be writing our own stories using the key skills we have learnt over the previous weeks. We can't wait to share them with you! We will also be finishing off our Scratch computing projects coding... We have loved this topic, especially the gaming element.
