## Leave of Absence Requests



If you need to take your child out of school during term time, you need to inform school in advance and complete a Leave of Absence Application Form. This should be given to the school office.

Requests will be given consideration in line with our Attendance Policy and guidance from the Nottingham City Local Authority. The attendance team will make a decision to whether the absence will be authorised.

Schools are no longer permitted to agree a Leave of Absence during term time unless for an **exceptional circumstance**.

**Absence for the reason of a family holiday is not considered an exceptional circumstance.** Parents still need to complete the Leave of Absence request form if they intend to take their child out of school for a holiday.

## EYFS

### This Week...

both F1 and F2 have been learning about Romeo and Juliet. In F1, we have focused on the theme of love and thought about who we love and how we show we love them. We have crafted hearts as we have learnt this is the symbol for love.

In F2, we have focused on the theme of families from Romeo and Juliet and been learning about our family trees. We have also created masks as Romeo and Juliet met at a masquerade ball.

F2 will be writing love notes to and from Romeo and Juliet and F1 will be learning about friends and enemies.

## KS1

### This Week...

we have been assessing our learning. We have been thinking about everything we have learned throughout the year and consolidated all of our knowledge.

In English, we have been focussing on Shakespeare. We have been watching and learning all about Romeo and Juliet. What a tragic love story! In the afternoons we have been doing lots of Shakespeare activities! We have completed some art work and even had a look at the history of William Shakespeare. We have even attempted to create our own Coat of Arms. Very fancy!

### Next week...

we will be continuing our Shakespeare learning. We will be completing more work about Romeo and Juliet. Year 2 will be focussing on time during maths and year 1 will be looking at place value to 100.

## Year 3/4

**This Week...** We have been really busy in our first week back... Year 4 have been completing their multiplication checks, using their super times table knowledge. Well done to all of you helping at home, preparing for the checks. It is our whole-school assessment time at the moment too, so the phase has been completing reading, maths, grammar and spelling tests. Results will be seen on school reports in the next few weeks. Alongside assessment, we have been celebrating the works of Shakespeare, in our topic lessons. Already, we have been learning about theatres and actors throughout history. We've discussed the similarities and differences of the Globe theatre compared to more modern theatres. Year 4's have had recent experience in a performance space, visiting the Albert Hall!

### Next week...

there will be lots of drama linked to Romeo and Juliet during English lessons plus more linked to Shakespeare in our topic lessons. We also have Martha Toogood working with some of our Year 3 doing drama activities!

## Year 5/6

**This Week...** Year 5&6 have become truly immersed in the land of Verona this week. We began by re-visiting the story and ensuring we understood the key themes, before building our understanding of the text using some impressive reading skills. We are going to be writing conversations between characters, so have spent the week doing drama and practising writing speech tags that are written to be effective in relation to what is being said. In the afternoons, the children have been designing front covers for the play. We have also completed our end-of-year assessments to support the teachers in assessing the progress the children have made in relation to the last ones we did. Year 6 have begun to work on their end of year production whilst Y5 have continued their DaART programme (there will be a graduation for this on the 9th July).

### Next week...

Recreating their front cover designs as scratch art. Exploring our opinions and how to have sensible, respectful conversations about differing opinions and developing our ideas further through philosophy for children related to Romeo & Juliet.
